





To download or search Texas

Apartment Association in your app
store. (Apple and Android)

- If you've downloaded the app for the TAA ONE Conference & Expo or a previous Board app, you'll need to uninstall and reinstall the app to make sure you've got the latest version.
- Search your app store for Texas
 Apartment Association and then choose the Feb 2025 BOD meeting.
- Click Create Account and enter event code FEB25BOD

BOARD ATTENDANCE POLICY

Who can attend TAA Board meetings? (Standing Rule 1)

- Voting and alternate delegates to the TAA Board of Directors
- TAA Past Presidents
- Members of any current TAA committee, council or task force
- Local association officers, executives, staff and designated attorneys representing local associations
- Members of the TAA Education Foundation Board of Directors
- NAA leadership and staff
- TAA staff and legislative consultants

BOARD ATTENDANCE POLICY

Who can attend TAA Board meetings? (Standing Rule 1)

- Past recipients of the Olin Steele, Frank Finch and Jennette Hunnicutt awards
- Local board members in the host city (not TSC board)
- Guests invited to attend by the TAA President or Executive Vice President – for example, local association Lyceum candidates
- Representatives designated by sponsor companies per their sponsor tier
- Spouses or significant others of eligible attendees are also welcome to attend social functions.






PURPOSE OF TAA BOARD

Article I, Section III, TAA Bylaws

The TAA Board of Directors shall have general supervision of TAA's activities and business affairs provided such general powers shall be exercised to further the declared objectives and purpose of TAA.





BOARD OF DIRECTORS AUTHORITY

Exclusive Authority – Article III, Section 1(b) of TAA Bylaws

- (1) Amend TAA Bylaws and Standing Rules;
- (2) Recommend changes to a Local Association territory to the National Apartment Association;
- (3) Review and approve reports of officer slates from the Leadership Committee;
- (4) Consider and approve any changes to membership dues no sooner than the next quarterly meeting of the Board following the release of any proposed new dues schedule from the Executive Committee;
- (5) Approve forms officially published by TAA and made available for use by the Members.
- (6) Approve substantial commitments and revenue sources which are not part of and are in excess of 10% of any pre-approved annual budget;
- (7) Endorse candidates for statewide office; and
- (8) Approve strategic plan for TAA.



BOARD MEMBER DUTIES

Fiduciary Duties – Article III, Section 1(c), TAA Bylaws

On all issues, the Directors shall be free to cast their vote(s) according to what they personally believe is in the best interest of the multi-housing industry in Texas, after due consideration for local, state and national concerns.

Members of the Board of Directors shall discharge their duties in good faith, with ordinary care, and in a manner, they reasonably believe to be in the best interest of TAA.







BOARD COMPOSITION & VOTING



- Each local association is entitled to appoint voting directors to the TAA Board of Directors based upon the membership size of their association.
 - 75% of each association's delegation must be owners/managers
- Each local association is entitled to alternate voting directors based upon their number of voting directors.
- Board votes are weighted.
- Local association AEs serve on the TAA Board of Directors in an ex officio capacity unless they are not compensated by the local association.




